

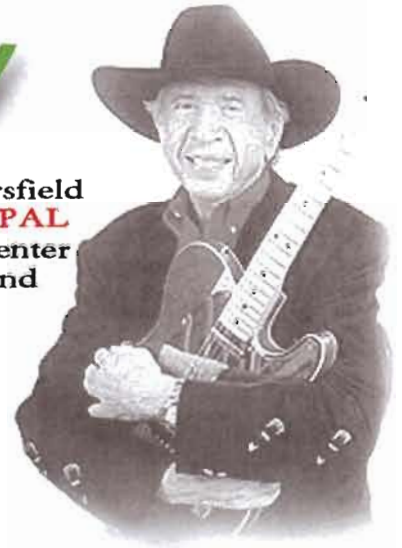
# Rally in the Valley

## A note regarding the drag races:

The races take place at the Famoso Drag Strip about 15 miles north of Bakersfield.

Saturday: Time trial qualifying until about 2 o'clock. Then the eliminations start for more intense racing at about 2:00PM. Then at about 7:30 PM they line up all the race cars on the track and have a crackle fest (start all engines for flames and ear deafening). There is an all day car show, swap meet, and pit viewing. Parking is free and entrance is \$18.00 with AAA card.



Cost for Rally: \$225.00 per coach with two persons.  
\$165.00 per coach with one person.

Directions to Bakersfield RV Resort: Exit Hwy 99 at White Rd, go west to Wible Rd (1<sup>st</sup> intersection), turn left , go south ½ mi to 5025 Wible Rd on right side.
